The Kids We Lose, A Documentary Film

Following the film will be a question and answer session with Dr. Ross Greene.

The Lower Merion School District & Radnor School Districts' Committees For Special Education, in partnership with Tredyffrin Easttown's BUILD, w/support from Delaware County Advocacy & Resource Organization, invite you to learn from Dr. Greene and his Collaborative & Proactive Solutions model, to help support students with challenging behaviors. Dr. Greene's Collaborative & Proactive Solutions model is recognized as an empirically supported, evidence based treatment by the CA Evidence Based Clearinghouse for Child Welfare (CEBC.) The research base supporting the effectiveness of the CPS model continues to grow.

Ross W. Greene, PhD, is the originator of the innovative, evidence-based approach known as Collaborative and Proactive Solutions (CPS), as described in his influential books, *Raising Human Beings: Creating a Collaborative Approach With Your Child*; *The Explosive Child: A New Approach For Understanding And Parenting Easily Frustrated, Chronically Inflexible Children*; *Lost At School*; and *Lost & Found*. Ross has worked with several thousand behaviorally-challenged kids and their caregivers, and he and his colleagues have overseen implementation and evaluation of the CPS model in hundreds of schools, inpatient psychiatry units, and residential and juvenile detention facilities, with dramatic effect: significant reductions in discipline referrals, detentions, suspensions, and use of restraint procedures and solitary confinement. he has infused the parenting and teaching of all kids with humanity, empathy, and compassion. Ross was on the faculty of Harvard Medical School for over twenty years, and is now Founding Director of the nonprofit *Lives In The Balance*. He is also an adjunct faculty member in the Dept of Psychology at Virginia Tech, and in the Faculty of Science at the University of Technology in Sydney, Australia. He is also Developer and Executive Producer of the recently released documentary film, *The Kids We Lose*.
